This event is open to all **BC Late Model** legal cars (including Agassiz, WESCAR, Saratoga) and **USA Late Models**. Cars must follow one of the following rules packages:

1. BC Late Model (WESCAR) with allowable total weight reduction of 50 pounds; **or**,
2. USA Late Model (South Sound Speedway rules).

Chose one rule package to follow, rules cannot be combined. Agassiz Speedway Officials have the right to modify based on competition.

**Race Information:**

<b>No dashes or heats</b>		
<b>A Main</b> (21 car max)	121 laps	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Top 17</b> qualifiers automatically qualify for A Main, plus <b>top 4</b> finishers in B Main</li> <li>• Invert TBD</li> </ul>
<b>B Main</b>	25 laps (if needed)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Start based on qualifying time (no invert)</li> <li>• Top 4 finishers transfer to A Main</li> </ul>

**Tire Rules:**

Four (4) **American Racer EC84** Tires purchased from Finishline Racing (1.800.734.3805).

**Note:** Tires used for qualifying will be marked and must be used to start the A Main.

**Track Affiliation:**

**Visiting car/driver from another racetrack must:**

- provide proof of racetrack membership;
- bring a copy of home track rules (if rules are not provided, car may be asked to conform to Agassiz Speedway Class Rules see Class Rules posted on website); and,
- must conform to Agassiz Speedways Safety Rules (see [Class and General Rules](#) posted on website).

**Visiting car/driver with no other racetrack affiliation (independent) must:**

- car must conform to Agassiz Speedways Safety rules (please see [Class and General Rules](#), posted on website).

**General Rules:**

- **No one under the age of 14** is allowed in the pits, no exceptions.
- No open-toed shoes, short shorts, or crop tops (back and stomach must be covered).
- **No alcohol or drugs before or during race events** (race event ends with the final checkered flag of the night).
- Please drive slowly through the pits, speeding in the pits may result in a fine or your car being parked.

- Use caution and slow down in the pit area (race cars and personal/tow vehicles). Please watch for cars, track vehicles, and people.
- If your car number is in use by an Agassiz member, you will be asked to select a different number, or put a letter after your number on the car, i.e.: 01X or you may use the initial of your last name. **Note: Our new scoreboard does not display letters.**
- We will try to provide you with a paved pit spot; however, you may park on the grass or gravel.
- **No parking or working on cars on the pit asphalt.**
- Use of floor jacks or jack stands is **not allowed** on asphalt. If floor jacks or jack stands are required, please use them on the gravel or in a concrete pit stall. Violation of this rule may result in a fine.
- If your car is leaking fluid, please drive on the grass or go straight to your pit stall.
- All drivers are required to have a **broom and fire extinguisher** in the pits with them.
- **No parking of tow vehicles, trailers, or personal vehicles in the pit area.** All vehicles must be parked in designated areas outside of the pits.
- Any vehicle going in or out of the track requires a walker on the right side of the trailer and/or car. If no trailer walker is present, the driver may receive a fine at the discretion of the Pit Boss and/or Executive.
- Once the pit gate is closed, there will be no leaving or entering, unless arrangements have been made with the Pit Boss and/or Track Officials. The back gate will remain closed until 20 minutes after the end of the final trophy presentation.
- No riding in the back of pick-ups or on trailers – this could result in a \$50 fine.
- No personal motorized vehicles allowed in the pits. This includes golf carts, quads, bikes, motorized scooters, coolers, wagons, etc. except for push vehicles (which must be pre-registered with the Pit Boss).
- Cars and tools may be left in the pit stalls overnight on Friday. The gates will be locked overnight and re-opened in the morning.

**Electronic Waivers:**

- Waivers must be completed for each person entering the pits.
- **Minimum age of entry to the pits is 14.** All minors are required to have a waiver completed by their parent or guardian and the individual waiver completed by the minor. Link above.

**Raceceiver:**

Must be used by all drivers (used by spotters for Late Models) for hot laps, time trials, dashes, heats, and main events. Ensure batteries are working. Checks will be made in the staging area.

**Late Model Spotters:**

- Radios are required for all drivers, crew chiefs and/or spotters.
- All spotters are required to have radio, be in contact with the driver, and must monitor race control during the race (raceceiver).
- All spotters must be in the spotter's area as set up by Agassiz officials during the race.

**Transponders:**

TR2, X2, or TransX (red version) transponders are compatible with our system. Transponders must be used during Friday practice, hot laps, qualifying, and racing events.

Track size is ¼ mile, medium – low banking.

**Camping:**

Dry camping is available in designated areas of the spectator parking lot or in Alm Park, (located on the road just past the pit gate). **Note: There is no power (or hook ups), and anything brought in must be taken out.** Please watch for signage for the most current details for any fire bans.

**Hotels:**
