## Len "Porky" Jansen Memorial Invitational Rules

### Car & Driver Registration:

Open to all BC Late Model legal cars (Agassiz, WESCAR/Keg at Agassiz Speedway weights).

**Early Bird Registration:** \$100 (must be registered and paid by August 5, 2024)

*\*includes weekend Pit Pass for driver.*

**Regular Registration:** \$150 (after August 6)

*\*does not include weekend Pit Pass for driver.*

### Schedule:

#### Friday, August 9, 2024

<b>2 PM</b>	Pit Gate opens
<b>4 to 7 PM</b>	Practice (open to all classes-Late Model, Mini, Street)
<b>7 PM</b>	BBQ in spectator parking lot

#### Saturday, August 10, 2024

<b>1 PM</b>	Pit Gate opens
<b>3 PM</b>	Hot laps for all classes
<b>4:10 PM</b>	Time Ins (full schedule will be posted closer to event)

### Race Information:

<b>A Main</b> (20 car max)	125 laps	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Top 16 qualifiers automatically qualify for A Main, plus top 4 finishers in B Main</li> <li>• Invert TBD</li> </ul>
<b>B Main</b>	25 laps (if needed)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Start based on qualifying time with full invert.</li> <li>• Top 4 finishers transfer to A Main</li> </ul>

### Tire Rules:

Four (4) American Racer EC84 Tires purchased from Andy Bodnar, Agassiz Speedway.

NOTE: Tires used for qualifying will be marked and must be used to start the A Main.

#### General Rules:

##### Visiting car/driver from another racetrack must:

- provide proof of racetrack membership;
- bring a copy of home track rules (if rules are not provided, car may be asked to conform to Agassiz Speedway Class Rules see Class Rules posted on website); and,
- must conform to Agassiz Speedways Safety Rules (see [Class and General Rules](#) posted on website).

##### Visiting car/driver with no other racetrack affiliation (independent) must:

- pay \$75 driver registration fee (in addition to pit fees) to race;
- must conform to Agassiz Speedway Class rules (please see Class Rules, posted on website); and,
- car must conform to Agassiz Speedways Safety rules (please see [Class and General Rules](#), posted on website).

#### General Rules:

- If your car number is in use by an Agassiz member, you will be asked to put a letter after your number on the car i.e.: 01X or you may use the initial of your last name.
- We will try to provide you with a paved pit spot; however, you may park on the grass or gravel.
- **No parking or working on cars on the pit asphalt.**
- Use of floor jacks or jack stands is **not allowed** on asphalt. If floor jacks or jack stands are required, please use them on the gravel or in a concrete pit stall. Violation of this rule may result in a fine.
- If your car is leaking fluid, please drive on the grass or go straight to your pit stall.
- Please drive slowly through the pits, speeding in the pits may result in a fine or your car being parked.
- All drivers are required to have a **broom and fire extinguisher** in the pits with them.
- **No parking of tow vehicles, trailers, or personal vehicles in the Pit Area**, all vehicles must be parked outside in designated areas.
- **No drinking or drugs allowed** to be consumed in the pits until the final checkered flag is flown for all races.
- Any vehicle going in or out of the track requires a walker on the right side of the trailer and/or car. If there is no trailer walker present, the driver may receive a fine at the discretion of the Pit Boss and/or Executive.
- Once the Pit Gate is closed there will be no leaving or entering, unless arrangements have been made with the Pit Boss and/or Track Official. The Back Gate will remain closed until 20 minutes after the end of the final Trophy Presentation.

Once racing has started, no matter the situation, no one is to step out onto the track without permission from the Pit Boss and/or Track Official.

### Electronic Waivers:

Electronic waivers can be found here: <https://agassizspeedway.speedwaiver.com/bocif>

- Waivers must be completed for each person entering the pits.
- **Minimum age of entry to the pits is 14.** All minors are required to have a waiver completed by their parent or guardian and the individual waiver completed by the minor. Link above.

### Raceceivers:

Must be used by all drivers (or used by spotters for Late Models) for Hot Laps, Time Trials, Dashes, Heats, and Mains. Ensure batteries are working. Checks will be made in the staging area.

### Transponders:

TR2, X2, or TransX (red version) transponders are compatible with our system. Transponders must be used during hot laps, qualifying, and racing events. If you don't have your own, rental transponders are available at the pit gate for \$20 for the weekend.

### Track Address:

### Track Info:

Track size is ¼ mile, medium – low banking.

### Camping:

Dry camping is available in designated areas of the spectator parking lot or in Alm Park, (located on the road just past the pit gate). **Note: There is no power (or hook ups), and anything brought in must be taken out.**

### Hotels:
