We're excited to bring something completely new to the track and give drivers and fans a day of racing unlike anything we've hosted before. With the added challenge of the Figure-8 format, drivers can expect plenty of action, strategy, and excitement from start to finish.

Please review this information package carefully, as it contains important event details, rules, schedules, and procedures to help ensure a safe, organized, and successful first Figure-8 event at Agassiz Speedway.

Schedule:

Sunday, October 4, 2026	
8:00 to 11 a.m.	Pit Gate Open (no entry after 11 a.m.)
11 a.m.	All cars must be in Tech line
11:30 a.m.	Drivers Meeting
12:00 p.m.	Racing starts

Note: All times subject to change and full race-day schedule will be posted in advance.

Figure- 8 Rules:

- Following Hope Motorsports Rules, attached
- No running on flat tires (will result in black flag)
- All cars must be washed and clean of all dirt and debris.
- Pit area: Outside of the track (fenced area at pit gate)
- Track area: Figure-8 will be inside the pit area.

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Event Info:

- Maximum of 24 cars (8 cars per heat)
 - Each car guaranteed 3 heat races and a chance at the championship race
- **Minimum of 15 cars to run the event**
 - Must have a minimum of 15 cars registered by September 27, 2026, at 11:59 p.m. for the event to go ahead.
- **Payouts:** We are seeking additional sponsorship for this event to increase the payouts. Minimum payouts are:

1 st	\$300
2 nd	\$200
3 rd	\$100

General Track Rules:

- **No one under the age of 14** is allowed in the pits, no exceptions.
- No open-toed shoes, short shorts, or crop tops (back and stomach must be covered).
- **No alcohol or drugs before or during race events** (race event ends with the final checkered flag of the night).
- Please drive slowly through the pits, speeding in the pits may result in a fine or your car being parked.
- Use caution and slow down in the pit area (race cars and personal/tow vehicles). Please watch for cars, track vehicles, and people.
- **No parking or working on cars on the pit asphalt.**
- Use of floor jacks or jack stands is **not allowed** on asphalt. If floor jacks or jack stands are required, please use them on the gravel or in a concrete pit stall. Violation of this rule may result in a fine.
- If your car is leaking fluid, please drive on the grass or go straight to your pit stall.
- All drivers are required to have a **broom and fire extinguisher** in the pits with them.
- If there is a call for brooms, at least one person from each team should help with track cleanup.
- **No parking of tow vehicles, trailers, or personal vehicles in the pit area.** All vehicles must be parked in designated areas outside of the pits.
- Any vehicle going in or out of the track requires a walker on the right side of the trailer and/or car. If no trailer walker is present, the driver may receive a fine at the discretion of the Pit Boss and/or Executive.
- Once the pit gate is closed, there will be no leaving or entering, unless arrangements have been made with the Pit Boss and/or Track Officials. The back gate will remain closed until 20 minutes after the end of the final trophy presentation.
- No riding in the back of pick-ups or on trailers—**this could result in a \$50 fine.**
- No personal motorized vehicles are allowed in the pits. This includes golf carts, quads, bikes, motorized scooters, coolers, wagons, etc. except for push vehicles (which must be pre-registered with the Pit Boss).

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Electronic Waivers:

- Waivers must be completed for each person entering the pits.
- Waivers are valid for the full 2026 race season at Agassiz Speedway.
- **Minimum age of entry to the pits is 14.** All minors are required to have a waiver completed by their parent or guardian and the individual waiver completed by the minor. Link above.

Pit Meeting:

- All drivers must attend the pit meeting (time to be posted on the race-day schedule).
- All generators must be shut down during the pit meeting and national anthems

Personal Vehicles:

Restrictions:

- Personal vehicles are prohibited from the pit area (exception of those used as push vehicles).
- Prohibited vehicles include: golf carts, ATVs, motorized bikes, bicycles, unicycles, ride-on coolers, etc.
- **No parking of tow vehicles, trailers, or personal vehicles** in the pit area. All vehicles must be parked in designated areas outside of the pits. See a track official request any special arrangements.

Raceceiver:

Must be used by all drivers (used by spotters for Late Models) for hot laps, time trials, dashes, heats, and main events. Ensure batteries are working. Checks will be made in the staging area.

Figure-8 will be run in the usual pit area of the track.

Camping:

Dry camping is available in designated areas of the spectator parking lot or in Alm Park, (located on the road just past the pit gate). ***Note: There is no power (or hook ups), and anything brought in must be taken out.*** Please watch for signage for the most current details for any fire bans. Donations are greatly appreciated to assist with the cost of camping (donation box available at the pit gate).

Hotels:

There are lots of hotel/motel options available in Harrison Hot Springs, approximately a 20-minute drive from the track. Visit www.tourismharrison.com/hotels-and-resorts for accommodation info.
